

¹⁵ One day some parents brought their little children to Jesus so he could touch and bless them. But when the disciples saw this, they scolded the parents for bothering him.



We Realize, the greater our own sinfulness, the greater His Holiness! The Greater the Cross!








Why is an Eternal perspective so important?

1 Cor 3:11-15

For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Christ. If anyone builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, their work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each person's work. If what has been built survives, the building will receive a reward. If it is burned up, the builder will suffer loss but yet will be saved, even though only a one escaping through the flames.
