FOLLOW ME

Luke 9:28-62

Jesus is speaking to the church and He says come and follow me! Follow me through the mountains and through the valleys. As our idea of greatness is reestablished, not being concerned with profile, numbers, riches or influence, but greatness in the eyes of our Father, we don't have to compare, compete or drag down anyone that is doing something else for Jesus.
