



WHAT'S YOUR DESIGNATION, ADDRESS & PRIORITY?

In Psalm 90 Moses gives us a glimpse into the life of one of the greatest leaders our world has ever seen. Allowing us to see how he thought about himself, where he lived and what he lived for. This challenges us to ask 3 questions:

#1 What is your designation?

A prayer of Moses the man of God. (Psalm 90)

Moses didn't live with a label over his life but rather learnt to live with his God given name or designation. While labels crush and kill you, a name and designation inspires you to live into the God given design for your life allowing you to place your unique signature upon the world.

#2 What is your address?

Lord, you have been our dwelling-place throughout all generations. (Psalm 90:1)

Moses lived in a basket, in a palace and in the desert, but He chose to identify God as his address. Where do you run for comfort, safety and strength?

#3 What is your priority?

*For a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by,
or like a watch in the night. (Psalm 90:4)*

How many days have you had? How many days have you got left? By Moses' calculations we each have less than 15 minutes for our entire lives. The question is, what are we going to do with the time the we have left?
