Paul and Silas were missionaries, they were spreading the Good News about Jesus. Then they ended up in jail, but they still praised God. The jailer saw something different in Paul and Silas and his life changed.

A missionary is a person who spreads the Good News of Jesus. We are all called to be missionaries.



DISCUSSION POINTS

How can we be missionaries?

- Paul and Silas travelled and as they did, they told everyone about the Good News of Jesus. They didn't stop praising God, even though they were thrown in jail. We can share the Good News with our friends at school. People will also be able to see that there is something different about us, because Jesus lives in our hearts from the moment we ask him to. Jesus changes everything.
- It is important to remember that Jesus saves lives. We are used in this process by sharing the Good News and living differently to the world because of the work that God does in our hearts. Jesus is our saviour.
