

## DEAR PARENTS,





Dear Parents, today's lesson is from Matthew 28:16-20. The Good News is too good not to share. Go and make disciples of all nations.

## DISCUSSION POINTS

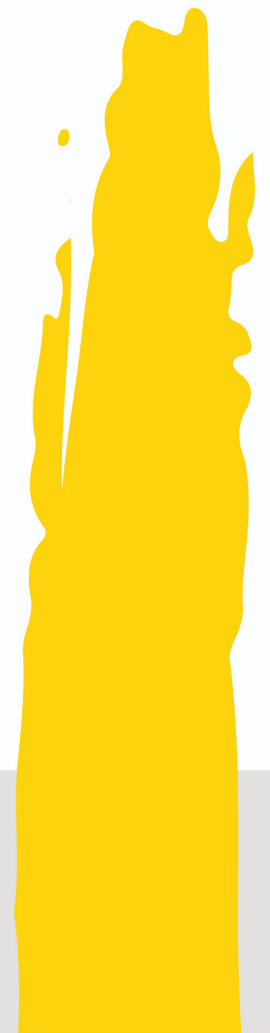
