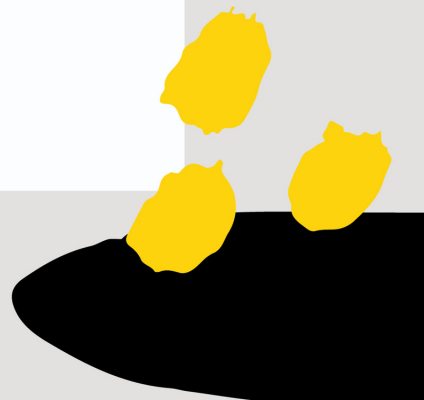







(LUKE 3:36-50, NIV)

STORY RE-CAP







